Application Process: Eligibility

- Pre-dissertation proposal doctoral students
- Studying topics related to poverty or inequality in the US
- Attending a US university
- Meet the NIH definition of disadvantaged background

Application Process: Application

- Complete online Application Form
- Have your dissertation advisor complete the <u>online Recommendation Form</u>
- Deadline is January 31, 2025



Application Process: Timeline

- January 31, 2025: Application Deadline
- Early March 2025: Notification of acceptance
- May 19-23, 2025: Workshop dates



Awards

- Chance to apply for a \$5,000 student research award
